

TRANSPORTATION TO ATHLETIC PRACTICE OPT-OUT FORM

Where practices for athletic competitions are held off school district grounds, it is expected that students will travel to and from such practices with their teams. However, parents may request that they be permitted to transport their children or that their children be permitted to transport themselves to and/or from such practices.

This form must be properly completed, signed and returned to the Athletic Office or School Administrative Office before any student is permitted to be transported to and/or from athletic practices as set forth above. Students will not be permitted to "carpool" to and/or from athletic practices.
