

8th Grade Medications and Modified Sports Information 2019-2020 School Year

Dear Parent/Guardian,

It is important to inform the school nurse of any health/medical issues (allergies/epipen, asthma/inhaler or diabetes) your student may have. If your child has allergies and/or asthma, you are required to provide the Emergency Care Plan Form and/or Asthma Action Plan. If your child requires prescription or over the counter medication in school, the Medication Authorization Form must be completed by the physician and signed by parent/guardian every school year. Medication supply, including over the counter, must be provided by you and dropped off at the Health Office in the original container.

Please return the completed forms to the Middle School Health Office **by September 6**, **2019. No medication will be given without a completed medication authorization form.** The forms you may need are on the IMS website.

*** **Modified Sports Program**. The fall season begins in September for students with completed and approved registration on the Family ID website. Online registration will open in August. Please direct any sport related questions to our Athletic Director (914-269-5491).

*** For all sports, a current physical (dated 9/1/18 or after) must be <u>uploaded</u> to FamilyID *** This is NEW for this year and will be required moving forward

Once the completed forms are uploaded, the School Physician will review and give the final clearance to each student. Students must register online **each** sports season (fall, winter, spring).
