General Supplies

Large 3-ring binder (2" recommended) with dividers or folders to separate by subject with loose-leaf, pens/pencils. Students can have 1 binder per class if they prefer with dividers but it is not necessary.

Social Studies

Global Studies I: 2 folders, three hole paper punch, white out, 100 index cards, see above

Global Studies II: see above for binder information

American Studies: 2 folders, see above for binder information

Economics: 2 folders, three hole paper punch, see above for binder information

Science

All courses: USB flash drive, see above binder information

Physics: 30 cm ruler, protractor, graphing calculator, 2 marbled composition books for labs

Earth Science: a 1.5 inch binder, a pack of dividers for binder, and a four-function or scientific calculator (note: New York State regulations will not allow a graphing calculator for these courses)

Chemistry: four-function or scientific calculator (note: New York State regulations will not allow a graphing calculator for these courses)

Honors Biology & Regents Biology: 2 single subject 8.5 x 11 inch spiral bound notebooks, 2 rolls of tape, 1 glue stick, 1 packet of 3x3 inch post its, four-function or scientific calculator (note: New York State regulations will not allow a graphing calculator for these courses)

AP Biology: 5 function calculator (+, -, *, /, √), 2 single subject 8.5 X 11 inch spiral bound notebooks; 2 rolls of tape; 1 glue stick; 1 packet of 3 X 3 inch post its.

Science Research: 1 5 inch binder, 2 packs of dividers for the binder

English

Grades 9-11: five dividers, one pocket folder, three hole paper punch, see above binder information

Grade 12: notebook

Physical Education

Appropriate athletic sneakers (no platform sneakers), shorts, T-shirt, sweat pants

Math

All courses: dividers, ruler, graph paper, spiral notebook, see above for binder information

Grades 9, 10, 11 & 12: Texas Instrument TI-84+ or TI-83+ graphing calculator.

AP Calculus: TI-89 is highly recommended.

Please note: Depending on the model, graphing calculators may range in price between approximately \$90 and \$150, but are required for Regents and AP courses/exams. You may consider buying a used one. If this presents a financial burden, the school has a limited number to be used in class. Please have your student notify his/her teacher in September. If purchasing a new graphing calculator, please do not open package and keep the receipt in case the wrong calculator was purchased.

World Language

All courses: 5 section dividers, composition notebook, two-pocket portfolios, French/Spanish dictionary (for use at home). See above for binder information.
