Whole School Instruction:

- Character Education and monthly themes related to *Habits of Mind,* such as Community, Working Together, Actions are choices we make every day, Fairness, Thinking Flexibly, Self Awareness/ Be Who You Are
- School Counselor goes into each classroom with lessons about *Habits of Mind*, Responsive Classroom, and *Second Step* curriculum
- Assemblies that highlight character education themes and whole school values
- Whole-school read alouds with books chosen for lessons about diversity, respect for others, and inclusion

Classroom Instruction:

- Morning Meetings in every classroom to build community and a culture of self awareness,
 respect for others, acceptance and honoring of differences
- Buddy-classes collaborate on different grade levels to form friendships with children in different grades and classes
- Read aloud, discussions, and activities to help children learn to engage in discussions respectfully
 - Read alouds that mirror our students
