There is absolutely no:

- Metal cleats
- Sunflower seeds
- Food
- ✤ Gum
- Smoking or use of any tobacco products at any time
- Alcoholic beverages
- Use of grills or any BBQ equipment
- Use of drugs or any illegal substances

- Colored sports drinks
- Pets of any kind
- Skateboards, bicycles, roller
 blades, or other non authorized recreational
 equipment
- Use of any soccer goals during lacrosse season
- No lacrosse games or practices without field netting in place.

Any organizations using the facility are responsible for the following:

- Building use form approved by school district prior to usage. Please carry a copy of the form for Field Marshall review.
- Reporting of any damage or spills that may have occurred during use.
- Returning of goals or any approved school equipment to the proper location after use.
- Keeping all athletes and spectators off the high jump and pole vault mats.
- Ensuring that all athletes do not walk on the track surface with cleats and cross only at the designated mat coverings.
- Keeping all spectators off the tower and out of any district storage area.
- Ensuring all team participants have received these rules and regulations prior to field use and have agreed to abide by these rules. Please keep the email proof that you have distributed the file, if you choose to distribute the rules in this manner.)

Violators of these regulations will have their access revoked and will be responsible for any related repair or replacement costs.
