TITLE I, PART A: IMPROVING BASIC PROGRAMS OPERATED BY LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES

The 2023-24 preliminary allocation of \$53,016 is used to partially fund the salary of a reading teacher.

This is also how Title IA funds were used in 2022-23.

Funds are set aside to purchase school supplies for lower-income students and transportation for parents to district meetings etc.



TITLE II, PART A: IMPROVING BASIC PROGRAMS OPERATED BY LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES

The 2023-24 preliminary allocation of \$21,054 will be used to support professional development relating to meeting New York State Learning Standards.

In 2022-23, the Title IIA allocation was used to support professional development related to meeting New York State Learning Standards in a hybrid or distance learning model.



TITLE III, Part A: English Language Learners and Immigrant Students

The 2023-24 allocation of \$3,494 will be used to purchase technology tools for use by English Language Learners and their teachers. This was funded using alternative funding sources.

For the 2023-24 school year, we will be providing these funds through a different funding source.



TITLE IV, PART A: STUDENT SUPPORT AND ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

The 2023-24 preliminary allocation of \$10,000 will be used to support professional development related to meeting New York State Learning Standards.

In 2022-23, the Title IVA allocation was also support professional development in science education.
