

Irvington Board of Education 2020-21 Trustee Candidates

For the 2020-21 school year, the Irvington Board of Education has three vacant three year terms. Registered voters of the Irvington UFSD community will be asked to vote for three candidates. Below are the three community members who are running for election. Voters will also have the opportunity to write in candidates.

Brian Friedman

Brian has served one term on the Board of Education and currently is President of the Board. He is a graduate of Irvington High School and returned to Irvington in 2005 with his wife, Amy. They have two daughters who attend Irvington schools, Emma (8th grade) and Jordan (4th grade).
