SCHOOL CLOSING PROCEDURES

Call the District's main number at 591-8500 for updated announcements on school delays/closings. One of the following two plans is used, depending upon the seriousness of weather conditions:

Plan A - If the weather is inclement (snow or ice) with improving conditions, the opening of school will be delayed by two hours. Buses will follow this delayed schedule.

Plan B - If weather conditions are severe with no improvement in the forecast, all schools will be closed for the day.

All announcements calling for either a delayed opening or closing of school for the day will be made no later than 7 a.m. whenever possible. In addition to the Emergency Notification phone message, the District's recorded phone message at 591-8500 as well as the District's website:

www.irvingtonschools.org, the announcements will also be featured on WHUD, WABC radio stations and websites. Additionally, tune to News12 on Cablevision service and Verizon Fios service, and the following local television news channels – ABC. **Please do not telephone the police for school information since these calls could interfere with emergency police business.**

In the event that school closings (due to weather or other emergencies) would bring the number of school days below state minimum requirements, additional days will be added to the school calendar.

Parent Notification System

The Irvington School District utilizes an instant alert service for emergency notifications or important messages. IUFSD will continue to use Parent Square to send e-mails, text messages, and telephone notifications to keep parents, community members and staff members informed about school closings and emergency dismissals. Specific communications will be sent to each family regarding the introduction of Parent Square. Your contact information contained in the District's student information system is used for contacting you regarding changes to the school schedule and other critical news; therefore, it is important that you inform your child(ren)'s school office of any changes to your contact information.

Professional Learning Early Release Day (PLRD)

On identified days during the months of, October through May, the schools will dismiss one hour early. This early dismissal occurs to provide our faculty and staff with additional time for professional learning, collaboration and curriculum development. The days are noted on the Calendar at a Glance as PLRD.
