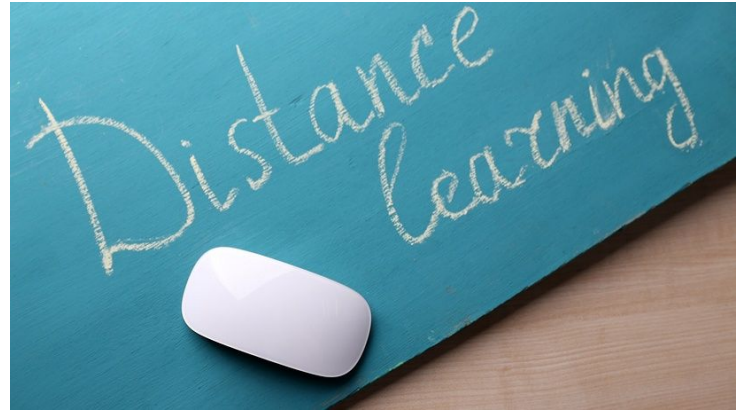




Foreign Language Corner
