

Information about the Fall 2022 Driver's Education Program at Maria Regina High School in Hartsdale can be found [here](#). The registration form is on the [Maria Regina Website](#). The Fall 2022 semester starts on October 4, 2022. The State Education Department is allowing Driver Ed Programs to conduct behind-the-wheel training. The protocol as of now, and until the State provides new guidelines, is that the parent/guardian has the option to opt in or out of the driving. If a student opts out, their parent will sign a form stating that their child performed the driving portion of Driver Education, under their supervision.

- Students have the option of doing in-person lectures or all-online assignments (asynchronous).
- We will be using Google Classroom for the All-Online students.
- Please understand that the tuition is the same for either lecture option, as this does not defray the cost of running the program.
- Students who successfully complete the course will receive the MV-285 (Driver Ed Completion Certificate). The MV-285 allows students to obtain a senior license at age 17.
- The aforementioned will be explained at the orientation for the students/parents. The orientation days are listed on the online registration form.
- The orientation will be **in-person** at Maria Regina H.S.
- The registration form is now available online.
