LECTURE REQUIREMENTS

Lectures are held at Maria Regina High School in the cafeteria. *From the NYS Dept of Ed: Effective June 30, 2023, ALL students MUST attend lectures in person.

- You must attend one lecture a week (16 weeks).
- Each lecture is **90 minutes**; 1 hour of learning + 15-30 min of make-up time if needed.

• You do not need to schedule your time for the lecture. Lectures are flexible and there are make-up opportunities.

DRIVING REQUIREMENTS

All driving lessons will commence and end at Maria Regina High School

*F<mark>rom the NYS Dept of Ed: Effective June 30, 2023, ALL students MUST attend & participate in the driving portion of the program.</code></mark>

- You must have a minimum of 6 hours of driving and 18 hours of observation with the Maria Regina Instructor (20 min per week x 18 weeks).
- Each driving lesson is approximately **80** minutes
- You will need to schedule lessons with Mark ahead of the program starting. Lessons will be assigned on a first come first serve basis.
- Driving lessons are available: Monday Sunday (7 days a week)

All students **MUST BE** 16-year-old by the first day of lecture, **July 8th**, **2025**, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Maria Regina's Driver's ed program is, as always, open to all other schools; Public, Private, & Parochial.

SUPERVISED DRIVING REQUIREMENT

- As per the State Education Department, all students MUST participate in the driving portion for a minimum of 6 hours and 18 hours of observation time with a Driving Instructor before the course ends.
- You must accumulate 50 hours of supervised driving (15 hours at night, 10 hours in heavy traffic). A Certification of Supervised Driving (Form MV-262) must be signed by your parent or guardian and brought to your road test.
- There are plenty of driving slots to accommodate even the busiest student.

UPON COMPLETION

Each student will receive:

- NYS Driver Education Course Completion Certificate (MV-285)
- 5-Hour Pre-Licensing Certificate (MV-278) after 5-hours of classroom instruction (if requested)
- Insurance Premium Reduction, where granted by an Insurance Company

- There will be a MANDATORY in-person orientation for the PARENTS (optional for the students)
- The orientation dates will be listed on the registration form, and you can choose your own date.
- Driving slots will be selected after the orientation presentation, on a first come, first served basis.

FAQ:

Do I have to attend the Parent Orientation?

Yes. The purpose of the orientation is to explain the program and how it works. Without an orientation it would be difficult to address and clarify everyone's questions. Also, driving lessons are expected to be scheduled at this time.

My child turns 16 after the first day of the course start date. Can I sign him/her up for that semester's course?

No. NYS Law states that ALL students must be 16 years old on day one and hold a valid NYS Learner's Permit. There are **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Can Student's complete the program remotely or all-online?

No. The NYS Department of Education changed the guidelines back to the Pre-COVID guidelines where all students must participate in the lecture and behind the wheel portions of the course in person.

Is the 5-Hour Certificate (MV-278) included in the Driver Ed tuition? Yes, The 5-Hour Pre-Licensing Certificate will be provided to any students who request one so they can schedule their road test before they receive the (MV-285) Driver's Ed Certificate. The original MV-278 **MUST** be brought to their road test.

When can students receive the MV-285 certificates?

The MV-285 certificates will be given out after the semester has ended and Students have completed all requirements. They will be available for pick-up in the Maria Regina Administration Office.

I will be taking my road test after the completion of Driver Ed. Do I still need to get a 5- hour certificate?

No. The Course Completion Certificate (MV-285) supersedes the 5-hour certificate; however, you can't make your appointment until after you get the certificate. The original MV-285 **MUST** be brought to their road test.

If I cannot attend the lecture I normally go to but I can't make it, can I go to the lecture another day?

Yes, Lectures are more flexible in the Fall and Spring session since the same lecture is given at least 7 times per week. You DO NOT need to notify anyone about what lecture you will be or won't be attending.

What if I can't make it to any of the lectures during the week?

You MUST make up any missed lectures before you can receive your completion certificate. There will be opportunities to make-up up to 4 missed lectures before semester ends.

FAQ:

I signed up to drive on a specific day/time but I can't make it. Can I attend another driving day/time without scheduling it?

Yes. However, since the driving time you picked at the registration is your secured slot for the entire semester, you must contact your Driving Instructor for availability and it is not guaranteed

If I miss a driving day, do I need to reschedule the driving right away? Yes. However, you have to call your Driving Instructor and reschedule for a future time and it is not guaranteed.

I want to be in the same car as my friend. Can I switch into their car? We will do our best to accommodate the students to be with their friends, however ALL switches MUST be mutually agreed upon by the students on week-1 and MUST be approved by your Driving Instructor.

If I have a question, can I call Mrs. Miller? It's preferable that all inquiries are via email.

We typically have over 200 students enrolled in the program which makes it difficult to manage following up on all phone calls. If a phone conversation is necessary, of course we can talk. email: <u>mrhsdrivered@mariaregina.org</u> Please DO NOT CALL Maria Regina H.S. for inquiries about the program.

Will Driver Ed be cancelled if it snows?

Yes. If schools are cancelled and/or if the roads pose a hazard, we will cancel the driving and/or lecture.

Does Driver Ed close during the Holiday breaks?

Yes. We model the lecture/driving days and times around the school calendar. We try to accommodate both public and private school calendars.

Note: There are no class lectures on Federal Holidays. However, there might be driving - we will announce that on a weekly basis.

When can I register for the next semester?

An announcement will be posted on the high school website when the online registration form is available.

How will I know of any changes to the Driver Ed calendar?

Announcements will be made at the lectures, announcements will be sent via email and posted to the Maria Regina Driver's Ed Website.
