NYS Regents exams will not be made up if school is closed due to a snow day.

Irvington MS, Main Street and Dows Lane schools will follow their usual AM and PM bus schedule during the exam period. The normal high school bus schedule (7:25 arrival, 2:55 departure) will resume on Monday, January 28th.

Midterm Week – Student Information

Midterms this year are Tuesday, January 22nd through Friday, January 25th. There are three time periods for classroom midterms each day with the exception of New York State Regents exams which are given twice a day. Please review the midterm schedule and consult your teacher if you have any questions.

Below are a few important aspects of midterm week that students should keep in mind:

- Students are expected to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of the exam
- Students are strongly encouraged to leave all electronic devices at home including cell phones, iPods, ipads, video games, etc. Any student observed to be using any electronic device while taking an exam or on a supervised break runs the risk of having his/her exam invalidated. If a student must bring an electronic device to school he/she will be asked to place that device in a designated area inside the exam room and have it returned to him/her upon completion of the exam when he/she is leaving.
- Students are strongly encouraged to leave all bags and backpacks at home. If a student must bring a bag or backpack to an exam, he/she will be asked to place the bag in the front of the room and have the bag returned to him/her at the end of the exam when he/she is leaving.
- Students should have no more than two exams during one exam day. If a student does in fact have more than two exams in one exam day, he/she should speak to his/her teacher(s) to arrive at an amicable solution.

In case of inclement weather please review the following procedures.

Classroom Midterms

- In case of a delay – the entire first test block will be moved to Friday, January 25th *
- If school is closed –the entire schedule will be moved forward one day and the midterm schedule will extend to Monday, January 28th. For example: If school is closed on Wednesday, January 23rd, then Thursday, January 24th will follow the original Wednesday schedule, Friday January 25th will follow the original Thursday schedule, Monday, January 28th will follow the original Friday schedule. If this should occur, please check the school website for updated information.

(*in case of a delay or school closure on Friday, January 25th, tests will be moved to Monday, January 28th. This will likely coincide with a regular classroom schedule. Should this situation occur during Midterm week, more information will be provided.)

Regents Exams

- In case of delay – the exam will be given. The morning Regents exams will start at 10 am.
- If school is closed – we will NOT bring students in. The exam will be given in June, unless New York State decides to allow the exam to be given prior to June (which has happened before).

Buses
