- Classroom teachers will communicate daily assignments by 8:00am via an email or Google Classroom
 - Directions will be clear and explicit
 - Teachers will support learning during the school day and will track student process
- Special Area teachers will post weekly activities on the <u>Dows Lane Website Special Areas</u>
 Special Area teachers will also include a Google Form link as an exit ticket
- Special Education teachers and Related Service Providers will communicate with students/ families who receive services as per each student's plan
- Instructional Coaches are consulting with teachers to help develop At-home learning assignments
- Nurse Fleming, our Psychologists, Social Worker, and School Counselor are all available via email to help support the well-being of students
- Students are expected to participate and engage in the daily work assignments
 - If a student does not participate, classroom teachers will contact families to check in and
 offer suggestions and assistance
