If a student's vehicle is found to be parked anywhere other than the senior upper lot during school hours, they will receive a parking ticket and a lien against their Home Access account until ticket fine is paid. Students/parents also agree that while driving on school property they will drive responsibly and not reckless or at high speeds - **otherwise all privileges of parking on school property will be revoked.**

Irvington High School Parking Privilege Policy

PARKING

Only Seniors that have registered their cars and received a parking permit are allowed to park on campus. Violators will be booted/ticketed. Registered Seniors are only allowed to park their vehicles in the upper lot. Seniors that are found to be parking anywhere other than the upper lot will receive a parking ticket and a lien on their Home Access account. Juniors who are violating the parking policy will be reported to the office where they too will receive a parking ticket and a lien on their Home Access account and a delay on getting their Senior parking permit. Any cars parked in a Fire Lane will be reported to the police department.

The High School Faculty parking lot and the Middle School Faculty parking lot (which include the spaces along the track)-are **restricted** to faculty and staff **ONLY**. No students, no parents, no visitors. These spaces are numbered and assigned to staff. Anyone other than staff parking in these spaces will risk the possibility of being blocked in. Students parking in a staff member's space will receive a parking ticket and have their Home Access locked. Parents and/or visitors who are blocked in will need to wait until staff member's classes are finished and teacher is free to come out to the lot.

SPEEDING

Remember you are within a school zone that includes Middle School students walking about campus. There are posted speed limits and there are **STOP** signs. By signing this **you** are agreeing that you will drive safe and responsibly when driving on school property and if found to be speeding or driving recklessly, **you WILL lose your parking privileges and will surrender your parking permit**. Please know that reckless driving is always reported to the High School main office.

Enforcement is in place from **6:30am to 3:30pm**.
