With that said, we are aware of the concern regarding our district's present dress code and we will begin the discussions to make changes, if necessary.

The dress code, which is part of the larger Code of Conduct, was established to help support a safe and orderly learning environment. However, we recognize the importance of revisiting the policies included in the Code with the express input of our stakeholders, which will allow all involved, including our students, to lend their voices to the continuous growth of our school community.

The fact is, we always want to improve our students' school experiences. If there is concern that the Code, in its present form, is inconsistent with the spirit of our school community, we want to address it. Further, we value our students' voice, especially with regard to decisions that may impact them so personally.
