As you may have heard, yesterday Governor Cuomo extended the school closures through Friday, May 15, 2020. At this time, it is not known whether schools will reopen after this date. I will continue to provide updates as the information becomes available.

During the extended closure, the Irvington schools will continue to support distance learning in accordance with the plans posted in the <u>Parents Guide to</u> <u>Distance Learning</u>. Additionally, the District will continue to distribute breakfast and lunch and will provide child care to children of medical care providers and first responders.
