

2020-21 Budget Vote & Board of Education Election Important Facts

How do I vote?

The 2020-21 Budget Vote and Trustee Election will be conducted using absentee ballots/vote by mail only.

When is the vote?

Ballots will be mailed to all registered voters during the week of May 25, 2020. All ballots must be received by the District Clerk by no later than 5:00 pm, June 9th.

• Note: to accommodate a timely delivery of your ballot, please mail it as soon as possible. Please mail it by Friday, June 4th to ensure it is received by the District clerk by the deadline.

Can I drop off my ballot in person?

The District will accept in-person delivery of ballots Monday, June 8th and Tuesday, June 9th from 9:00 am - 5:00 pm. All ballots must be placed in the District's secured drop box, located at the Dows Lane Elementary School, District Office entrance.

How do I register to vote?

Due to the current pandemic, no in-person voter registration will be held. Those wishing to register to vote may do so at the DMV website by clicking here.

To be a qualified voter you must be a US Citizen, at least 18 years old by June 9, 2020, a School District resident for 30 days immediately preceding the vote and not otherwise prohibited from voting. Qualified voters who are registered with the Westchester County Board of Elections are eligible to vote at school district elections. If you are not sure if you are registered or did not receive a ballot, contact Pauline Davies at the email or phone number listed above.
