



Important Information- Budget Vote & Board of Education Trustee Election

June 8, 2020

Dear Irvington School Community,

As you may have read in the local press, by way of executive order, Governor Cuomo extended the deadline for absentee ballots to be returned to school districts.

Specifically, "The Governor also announced he will issue an Executive Order extending the deadline for school districts to receive school budget ballots. To be counted, school budget ballots can be accepted by hand delivery through 5pm on June 9th and received by mail through June 16th by the school district."

In simple terms the submission of ballots are due as follows:

- **June 9, 2020, 5:00 pm: Deadline for ballots to be submitted in person to the Irvington UFSD.** Ballots may be placed in the secure lockbox outside the District Office entrance, which is located at Dows Lane Elementary School, 6 Dows Lane, Irvington, NY on Monday, June 8th and Tuesday, June 9th between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm. *NOTE: Voters will not be able to drop off ballots in person after June 9th, 5 pm.*
- **June 16, 2020, 5:00 pm:** Deadline for mailed ballots to be received by Irvington UFSD. All mailed ballots received after this date and time, will not be counted in accordance with the Governor's executive order.

Additionally, as a result of this change to voting deadlines, the Board of Education will not meet to accept the results of the election until Tuesday, June 16th at its regularly scheduled meeting. Therefore, the BOE meeting scheduled for Tuesday, June 9th has been cancelled. Additionally, on June 16th the District will broadcast a live video-only streaming of the canvassing of the ballots that will begin at 5:00 pm in the Dows Lane Gymnasium. A link to this broadcast will be posted on the District website Monday.
