

Important Food Service Communication

Dear IUFSD School Community,

We are pleased to share with you important details on the 2020-21 Food Services Plan. As we have stated in our various reopening plan presentations, Food Services, just like school operations, will look a little different this year. Our menu offerings have been simplified, items will be pre-packaged for easy pickup or delivery, we will use pre-ordering systems for the elementary schools and orders for students in distance learning and finally, maybe the best news, meals will be free until further notice. The free meals will be covered by National School Lunch for the time being! This applies to standard meals only; snacks and additional beverages are excluded.

The flyers below provide details for both the elementary and secondary school food service programs. They can also be accessed by clicking here. Included in these flyers are the links to the pre-order forms, *My School Bucks* to add funds to meal accounts for snacks, and our Food Services webpage where you can access the Free/Reduced Lunch application. It is important that any family requiring assistance complete this form by September 30. This will enable a student to participate in the free/reduced lunch offering, as eligible, when the meal fee waiver ends.

If your child has any special dietary needs, please feel free to contact Gloria Estrada, our Aramark Food Services Director at <u>gloria.estrada@irvingtonschools.org</u>. At the elementary level, any food allergy information should be provided to the school nurse.

We realize that you may not be as familiar with your child's student number as they are, but you will need to include their number when using the pre-order forms. To view your child's student number, please log in to Home Access, which can be accessed <u>by clicking here</u>.

- For <u>morning</u> Kindergarten and First Grade students only, lunches will be delivered for students to take home due to timing of program and lunch periods.
- Meal price is \$0 for all students until further notice. Once the National School Lunch program ends the free meals, the cost is \$3.25 unless Free/Reduced Lunch which is \$0.
- All Free/Reduced Lunch applications for 20-21 should be made by September 30. Families must reapply each year <u>Irvington Food Services</u>.
- Any ala carte items will be charged to student accounts (must have positive balance to charge). Payments through My School Bucks : <u>MySchoolBucks</u>

- Meal price is \$0 for all students until further notice. Once the National School Lunch program ends the free meals, the cost is \$4.25 unless qualified for Free/Reduced Lunch which is \$0.
- All Free/Reduced Lunch applications for 20-21 should be made by September 30. Families must re-apply each year <u>Irvington Food Services</u>
- No pre-orders for <u>campus</u> meal selections.
- All ala carte, snack or additional beverage items will be charged to student accounts (must have positive balance to charge). Payments through My School Bucks preferred (cash discouraged): <u>MySchoolBucks</u>
