

## **District Capital Project Update**

Dear Irvington School Community,

Since my last update on the progress of the Irvington UFSD capital project, there has been a lot of forward movement toward launching construction on the Phase 1 projects. Last summer we completed the installation of a new boiler at Dows Lane, and now I am excited to share that we are breaking ground on the construction of the Campus Learning Pavilion by Meszaros Field. This building will contain space for storage for our athletic equipment, a treatment room for the Athletic Trainer, a concession stand, public restrooms and an outdoor classroom space on the roof of the building. You will start to see contractors at the MS/HS Campus, ably managed by Triton Construction, the District's construction manager. Areas under construction will close to only provide access for contractors and to provide for student and community safety. During times of construction, the District and its contractors will be mindful of student traffic patterns, especially with regard to construction material deliveries, to ensure a safe environment is maintained for all. At times, minor inconveniences may occur, which are inevitable, but will be managed to limit the impact on traffic.

Then in late June, construction will begin on the campus enclosures, other enhancements at the Middle School and Science buildings and much needed work at Dows Lane Elementary.
